### **COVID-19: Chief Medical Officer reminds people of advice to stop spread of coronavirus**

Coronavirus cases are once again increasing in Wales, with the latest ONS figures estimating that one person in every 30 has COVID-19. The Chief Medical Officer for Wales is reminding people to follow simple steps to protect themselves from the risk of catching COVID-19, which include:

- getting vaccinated
- wearing face coverings in crowded indoor settings
- anyone with symptoms should take a lateral flow test (free until 31 July 2022), and stay at home and limit contact with others. Information on how to order a LFT kit is available here:
