COVID-19: COVID Pass for events and nightclubs announced

From Monday 11 October 2021, people will be required to show the NHS COVID pass to demonstrate they are either fully vaccinated, or have had a recent negative Lateral Flow Test, to enter the following venues and events:

- Nightclubs
- Indoor non-seated events of more than 500 people, where people are mixing closely for prolonged periods
- Outdoor non-seated events of over 4,000, where people will be mixing closely for prolonged periods
- Any event, of any nature, which has more than 10,000 people in attendance

At Alert Level 0, carrying out a coronavirus risk assessment continues to be a legal requirement for all businesses, employers and event organisers and they need to take reasonable measures to minimise the risk of exposure to, and spread of, coronavirus. Particular attention should be paid to:

- Social distancing, particularly in busy areas
- Good ventilation
- Good hand hygiene
- Wearing of face masks – indoor public places, including on public transport, in shops and in healthcare settings
