COVID-19: COVID Pass no longer required for indoor or outdoor events

From today (18 February 2022), the domestic COVID Pass will no longer be required for entry into indoor or outdoor events and venues, including nightclubs, cinemas, theatres and concert halls. Venues can still choose to use the domestic COVID Pass on a voluntary basis as part of their coronavirus risk assessment and reasonable measures.

Carrying out a coronavirus risk assessment continues to be a legal requirement for all businesses, employers and event organisers for the time being and reasonable measures to minimise the risk of coronavirus must be implemented. The latest Alert Level 0 guidance for business can be found at:
