COVID-19: Alert Level 0

Here's a quick summary of the changes for businesses at Alert Level 0:

- All businesses and premises can re-open
- No legal limits on the number of people who can meet
- No legal requirement for 2m social distancing, table service or controlled entry
- By now, collecting customer information should form part of a business risk assessment, even though collecting details for Test, Trace, Protect is no longer required by law
- Face coverings must still be worn in all public indoor places, with the exception of pubs, restaurants and cafes and education settings
- Carrying out a coronavirus risk assessment continues to be a legal requirement for businesses, employers and event organisers, and they must take reasonable measures to minimise the risk of exposure to coronavirus
