Before deciding on a proposal to re-organise schools, the Local Authority (Gwynedd Council) must inform you as the school pupils, as well as other relevant consultees, and give you the opportunity to express an opinion on the proposal.

Provide schools that are important to the community


Strengthen the Welsh Language

What is the proposal in the Bangor Catchment Area?



The option proposed in the Bangor catchment area is to create a new school for Ysgol y Garnedd. Close Ysgol Babanod Coedmawr and Ysgol Glanadda and offer a place for the pupils at (the new) Ysgol y Garnedd. Ysgol y Garnedd's new building will be larger that the curent building, and will be able to offer a place for up to 420 pupils.



This this change means?

- Ysgol Babanod Coedmawr and Ysgol Glanadda will close
- The new Ysgol y Garnedd will be moved to a new site, not far from the current site.
- Ysgol Coedmawr and Ysgol Glanadda pupils will transfer to Ysgol y Garnedd once the building work is completed.

- Create stability in the area
- Ensuring good education for all
